

## VII. Passengers Eligible to Reduced Fares

59. Children who have not started acquiring primary education according to the General Education Law (hereinafter - pre-school children) have the right to travel on the train free of charge, presenting a free ticket with the year of birth of the child, received at the ticket office or from the ticket inspector. Pre-school children may travel on the train only accompanied by an adult.
60. The following categories of passengers are entitled to travel on the train free of charge, presenting a corresponding certificate together with a free ticket received at the ticket office or from the ticket inspector with the last four digits of the number of the certificate:
  - 60.1. Orphans and children left without parental care who are in foster families, guardianship, child care institutions or studying in general or vocational education institutions, or at universities and colleges until the age of 24, as well as Ukrainian civilians – unaccompanied children from the age of 7 until the child reaches the age of 19, presenting a certificate for the provision of social guarantees
  - 60.2. Persons up to 18 years of age with disability and a person who accompanies a person up to 18 years of age with disability (the accompanying person may not be younger than 13 years of age), presenting the disability certificate or the disability certificate together with an identity document or a student's certificate if the disability certificate does not contain a photo
  - 60.3. Persons with Group I disability and a person who accompanies a person with Group I disability, persons with Group II disability, presenting the disability certificate or the disability certificate together with an identity document or a student's certificate if the disability certificate does not contain a photo
  - 60.4. Politically repressed persons, presenting a certificate of politically repressed person
  - 60.5. Participants of the national resistance movement, presenting a certificate of participant of the national resistance movement
61. The category of recipients of fare reductions with Latvian Honorary Family Cards "Goda ģimene" are eligible to the following fare reductions for travelling on a train:
  - 61.1. Presenting an identity document or a valid driver's licence together with the certificate "Goda ģimene":
    - 61.1.1. **50% discount** on one-way tickets
    - 61.1.2. **40% discount** timed tickets
  - 61.2. Pupils and students (up to the age of 24) presenting an identity document, or a pupil's or student's card together with the Card "Goda ģimene" - **90% discount** on one-way tickets
  - 61.3. All members of a Latvian Honorary Family, presenting documents referred to in Paragraphs 61.1 or 62.2, on **4 May, 11 and 18 November** - **100% discount** on one-way tickets.
