

VIII Procedures for Transport of Animals

62. It is allowed to transport dogs, cats, ornamental birds, domestic or ornamental bird chicks, which are to be transported in accordance with the procedures specified in the legislation regulating the protection of animals. The passenger transporting an animal shall take care that the animal does not disturb other passengers.
63. No more than 10 (ten) dogs may be carried in one train wagon, no more than 2 (two) dogs accompanied by one owner may be present in one seat compartment.
64. On the train, a dog shall be transported with a muzzle, keeping it on a leash or, if it does not have a muzzle, it shall be placed in a bag, container or cage suitable for animal transportation. Other animals shall be transported in suitable bags, containers or cages. It is forbidden to transport a dog or any other animal on a seat.
65. The cost of transporting one or several animals (in the same cage, container or bag) corresponds to the fare for one baggage unit.
66. Passengers who are entitled to a reduced fare in the territory of Latvia, shall pay for the transportation of one or several animals in accordance with the tariffs approved by the carrier.
67. A dog that serves as a guide or assistant shall be transported free of charge, provided that the requirements of legislation of animal protection for such dogs are met. Such dogs may be transported on the train without a muzzle, special bag, container or cage, and the dog's owner or keeper shall ensure that the dog does not pose a threat to the safety, health or life of passengers on the train and that the dog behaves appropriately.
